<b>LIVE NUDE GIRLS</b>	Multiple Cities Nationally	2019-2021
An interactive exhibit exploring the politics of the body and the heightened pressure and preciousness of physical closeness as we adapt to new norms of connection. In person, in portraiture, and on screen, this work explores our embodied experiences in a culture strung between extreme self-promotion and fourth generation feminism during a time of extreme vulnerability as a species. Co-created messages born from interviews and painted directly onto the body (usually backwards) result in mirrored reflections for all participants.

Customized, painted, and decoupled window boxes, planters, pots, and birdhouses with poetry written in live-time while interviewing long-time South End residents. P.S.I. is a civic design competition that reimagines and enhances Boston's public spaces, this year bringing a slice of the city's green spaces to homes in Boston.

Live-time prophetic poems written live while interviewing attendees at the Graduate Festival (2019) and the Smith Campus Center Reopening (2018), followed by an online photography exhibit of select pieces.

A 200 square-foot mural bloomed with live-response poetry from interviews about experiences of immigrating to the United States and current anti-immigration policies.
